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Grim Numbers


5190 construction workers died in 2016

"To assure safe and healthful working conditions for working men and women by setting and enforcing standards and by providing training, outreach, education and assistance."

Employer's Responsibilities

- Workplace free from recognized hazards
- Comply with OSHA standards
- Provide training
- Keep illness and injury records
- Provide OSHA required medical exams
- Give employees access to their medical records
- Provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Do not discriminate
- Post OSHA citations and hazard correction notices



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Your Rights

- A safe and healthful workplace
- Know about hazardous chemicals
- Information about injuries and illnesses
- Request corrections from your employer
- Training
- Examine exposure and medical records
- File an OSHA complaint
- Participate in an OSHA inspection




