### GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All rules and expectations for WSF and other Youth and 4-H Show animal exhibitors will be applicable to the 4-H Dog Show.
2. 4-H members qualify to enter the State 4-H Dog Show by competing in their county 4-H dog show AND:

a) **Showmanship** - ~~youth won showmanship at county fair or the county 4-H Educator designates the youth Champion Junior, Intermediate or Senior.~~

b) **Obedience** - ~~received a qualifying score of (170) or above.~~

c) **Conformation** - youth placed in the top 4 at county fair.

d) **Agility and Rally** - ~~must compete at the same level at the State Show that they qualified for at the county level.~~

All dogs must be at least 6 months of age by May 1st to compete at the State 4-H Dog Show and 1 year of age by

May 1st for agility classes.

4. ~~All dogs must be accompanied by a current Rabies vaccination or have been vaccinated within the last 12 months. Rabies vaccination of all dogs is strongly recommended. Dogs participating in the 4-H program should follow their veterinarian's recommendations for infectious disease vaccinations. At minimum, they should be current on vaccination for rabies, distemper, parvo, and have received a bordatella (kennel cough) vaccination within the last 12 months.
