Each year members are awarded seals for their work in the 4-H program. Members can earn green, silver or gold seals to add to their Certificate of Achievement. Members can also earn points for their involvement in 4-H to be part of the Honors Club. Honors club members with 19 points receive a 4-H trip scholarship worth \$500.00.

Seal awards are given based on the checklist below. Documentation for silver and gold seal completion can be found in the online 4-H Record Book. The section where this documentation is found is listed after each item.

Completion of Green Seal - 0 points

- Member is enrolled in at least one project.
- Member is enrolled in a club.

Completion of Silver Seal - 1 point

- Completion of Green Seal requirements.
- Member has exhibited or shared what they learned.

- Member has set goals for at least one project.

- Member has shared skills gained for at least one project.
