## **WYOMING STATE 4-H WOOL JUDGING CONTEST**

This Contest is held at the UW Wool Lab at the University of Wyoming Student Farm located by Hansen Arena.

#### **TENTATIVE SCHEDULE**

Friday, April 19th, 2024

3:00 p.m. Check-in (Wool Lab Classroom at UW Wool Lab Building)

3:30 p.m. Orientation

4:00 p.m. Wool Judging Contest begins.

The awards ceremony will take place at 2:00 pm on April 20<sup>th</sup> at the Animal Science Meat Lab on the University of Wyoming Campus (after the Meat Judging Contest). <u>Lunch will be provided to those who are registered.</u>

### **CONTESTANT ELIGIBILITY**

Youth entries are submitted by either the family or County 4-H Educator and will be verified using zSuites. Youth will compete as individuals. Counties can enter an unlimited number of youth in each age division. Counties will designate the individuals that will make up teams. Junior team designations can be from junior or intermediate age divisions, while senior teams must be in the senior age division.

## **CONTEST CLASSES & JUDGING**

Judging classes for the contest will consist of the following categories:

6 Wool Classes (50 points per class):

Wool Classes, Possible Points = 300

6 Sets of Questions (13) from each of the placing classes (2 points per question)

*Questions, Possible Points = 300* 

Grading Line (15 fleeces)

*Grading, Possible Points = 225* 

Total possible points for the contest (all three categories) is 825

Contestants will be allowed 12 minutes for each judging class and 25 minutes for the Fleece Grading Line.

\*\*\* Optional Reasons – Any Senior, Intermediate or Junior can give the optional reasons. This will not be scored with the other classes or affect the overall scores. There will be separate prizes for those who choose to give reasons. \*\*\*
