

WYOMING STATE 4-H WOOL JUDGING CONTEST

The awards ceremony will take place at 1:30 pm on April 29th at the Animal Science Meat Lab on the University of Wyoming Campus (after the Meat Judging Contest). Lunch will be provided to those who are registered.

CONTEST CLASSES & JUDGING

Judging classes for the contest will consist of the following categories:

6 Wool Classes (50 points per class):

Wool Classes, Possible Points = 300

6 Sets of Questions(13) from each of the placing classes (2 points per question)

Questions, Possible Points = 300

Grading Line (15 fleeces)

Grading, Possible Points = 225

Total possible points for the contest (all three categories) is 825

Contestants will be allowed 12 minutes for each judging class and 25 minutes for the Fleece Grading Line.

zScore will be used for scoring the contest. Any needed 4-H Wool Judging Placings & Questions sheets or Grading Line forms will be provided by the State 4-H Office. Judging participants are encouraged to take personal notes, but there will be no papers, notes, or reference guides allowed for the contest in any fashion.

- Western National Roundup Wool Judging Contest in Denver, CO (January)

Various items will be awarded for Junior and Senior teams and individuals.
