Prepare for State I Fair Wyoming State 4-H Dog Show

WHAT TO PACK:

- Paperwork including Health Certificate, Dog ID and Jump Height card.
- Crate and a light sheet to provide cover from the sun.
- Bucket or bowl and *plenty* of water for you and your dog. Remember, they will be drinking more so will need more potty breaks.
- Spray bottles, ice packs, neck bands, wet towels, fan and items to keep your dog cool.
- Treats (both people and dog) and poop bags.
- Sunscreen, water and chairs.
- Conformation and Showmanship:
 - A nice outfit with shoes you can run in
 - Conformation leash, brush, treats, treat bag and baby wipes to clean dirty spots
 - Make sure you know body parts, breed, age, etc.
- Rally:
 - Normal collar or choker collar and a leash
- Agility:
 - Flat or rolled collar (no tags) and a leash

BEFORE STATE FAIR:

- Bathe your dog. Try an old Ivory dish soap bottle to dilute the dog shampoo. Be sure to do 2 rinses.
- Trim toenails, clean ears and brush teeth. Trim hair on bottom of feet.
- Have different people approach and touch your dog.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- It is your responsibility to keep your dog safe: be aware of your surroundings and do not bring your dog close to other dogs. Keep their attention on *you!*
- Do not let your dog drink out of other water sources or pick up something from the ground to eat. You may even want to bring water from home or use bottled water to keep your dog from getting diarrhea.
- Do not let your dog stare down other dogs or people. Do not let other dogs stare down your dog.
- Do not try to break up a dog fight.
