Basic Handling: Working around horse, grooming and care, correct halter work.	10		
Riding:			
A. Two-track or half pass both directions at walk, trot and lope or canter.	10		
B. Flying change of leads in figure 8 or connected circles – small circles (8'S) slower and collected; large circles (8's) at a faster gait.	15		
C. Flying change of leads on a straight-away at a lope or collected canter (minimum of 3 changes)	15		
D. Trot and extended trop and back to trot (sitting to rising back to sitting for English).	5		
E. Lope or canter to hand gallop and back to lope or canter.	5		
F. Pivot – ¼ turn, ½ turn in the opposite direction, then ¼ turn to original position (English – turn on haunches from halt; ½ turn in each direction.)	10		
G. Roll-back both left and right from lope; must be executed in open (English – half-pirouette at the canter; one-half turn both directions).	10		
H. Correct sliding stop or balanced halt from canter.	10		
I. Proper equipment and dress.	10
