



CHAPERONE JOB DESCRIPTION

YOUR PURPOSE:

To provide overnight supervision to 4-H youth. To support 4-H programming efforts as directed by the event staff or 4-H Educator.

MEASURE OF SUCCESS:

4-H members have a positive experience, and are provided with a safe environment to learn and grow through 4-H programming efforts.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in 4-H chaperone training.
- Adhere to the Wyoming 4-H policies.
- Assure a safe and healthy environment through support and enforcement of all rules.
- Help assist youth, volunteer, and UW Educator in solving problems.
- Set a good example for 4-H members at all times.
- Know the names and faces of the 4-H members you are chaperoning.
- Assist the 4-H Educator and other staff with experiences during the overnight event.
- Provide appropriate discipline when behavior problems arise.
- Understand and be willing to follow proper emergency procedures if needed.
- Understand and be willing to follow any additional rules of the facility and event you are chaperoning.

TIME REQUIRED:

2 – 7 days (depends on event being chaperoned)
