



VOLUNTEER COACH JOB DESCRIPTION

YOUR PURPOSE:

To provide overall leadership and educational opportunities to a group of youth interested in judging opportunities around a specific subject area like livestock, horse, meats, produce, etc. To be a contact person for the judging group with the county UW Educator and the county 4-H program.

MEASURE OF SUCCESS:

Judging teams and/or individuals are participating in local and state educational and competitive learning opportunities. Members and parents are informed of judging related 4-H activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coordinate and organize educational opportunities throughout the year to prepare youth for competition.
- Teach specific skills to 4-H members to enhance communication and decision making skills.
- Provide positive feedback to members, letting them know things they are doing well and ways to make improvements.
- Recruit new members to be part of judging experiences.
- Advise members and parents about opportunities to showcase their skills including dates, times, and locations.
- Work with the UW Educator to develop a plan as to how teams will be selected and communicate the plan effectively with members and parents.
- Work to recruit other volunteers and experts to share their knowledge.
- Accompany youth to local, regional, state, and national competitions.
- Adhere to the Wyoming 4-H Policies.

TIME REQUIRED:

10-15 hours monthly (depends on club size and activities)
