MEMORANDUM FOR ALL DETACHMENT 940 GMC CADETS

SUBJECT: Honor and Warrior Flight Competition

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to outline the criteria for earning the title of Honor and Warrior Flight for the Spring 2017 semester.
2. Honor Flight will be based on 3 criteria: weekly Warrior Knowledge Quiz (WKQ) score average, Open Ranks Inspection (ORI) score average, and attendance at Physical Training (PT), Leadership Laboratory (LLAB), and Flight Meetings. Whichever flight earns the higher WKQ score average will receive 2 points, and the losing flight will receive 1 point for trying. No points will be given if a quiz is skipped. Whichever flight earns the higher ORI score average will receive 13 points (only 1 official LLAB ORI in 13 weeks of training), and the losing flight will receive 6.5 points for trying. Any flight demonstrating perfect attendance at LLAB, PT, and Flight Meeting for a given week will receive 2 points, but no points if there are any absences.
3. Warrior Flight will be based on 3 criteria: Fitness Assessment (FA) score average, attendance for Detachment extracurriculars, and individual flight time. Whichever flight earns the higher FA score average will receive 13 points (only 1 official FA in 13 weeks of training), and the losing flight will receive 6.5 points for trying. Cadets that participate in Det extracurriculars (recruiting, retention events, Color Guard, Det intramurals, etc.) will receive 1 point for their flight. If five cadets from the same flight attend an event, their flight earns 5 points. 1 point will be awarded for every hour (rounded down to the nearest 0.5 hour) of individual flight time that takes place outside of scheduled ROTC activities to include flight meetings where the entire flight is in attendance. Examples of valid individual flight time are flight bonding events, flight academic study sessions, marching practice, flight workouts, etc. Any individual flight time shall be reported by the flight to their flight commander so that he/she may note any hours in his/her weekly update.
4. At midterm awards during LLAB 7, the current leaders of Honor Flight and Warrior Flight will be announced. At the end of the semester, the leaders of Honor and Warrior Flight will be awarded the official Honor and Warrior Flight Awards and ribbons, per AFROTCI 36-2011 10.10.6, 7. The accumulated points of each flight for Honor and Warrior Flight will be posted weekly on the Cadet Wing Commander's office door.
