

STUDY ABROAD CHECKLIST – AAST4990: EXPLORING BLACK BRITAIN

- Schedule an appointment with Student Health to secure medical clearance to study abroad.** You will submit the medical clearance form with your application.
- Application Form for Study Abroad due December 1st, 2014** – turn your application form and medical clearance form in to Moriah Hager, African American & Diaspora Studies, Ross Hall 111 (766-2481).
- Register** – If you have not already taken the spring AAST3670: The African Diaspora course, which is a prerequisite for the study abroad, you should register during advising week. You should also register for the study abroad itself, which is listed as AAST4990: Exploring Black Britain.
- Pay first non-refundable installment of the deposit for \$1,000 by January 30th, 2015** – This may be done by delivering a check (to African American & Diaspora Studies), or getting a form from Moriah Hager to use so that you can pay with your Visa Card in the Registrar's office.
- Pay second non-refundable installment of the deposit for \$1,000 by March 20th, 2015** – This may be done by delivering a check (to African American & Diaspora Studies), or getting a form from Moriah Hager to use so that you can pay with your Visa Card in the Registrar's office.
- Book Your Flights** – You are responsible for booking your round-trip flight from the United States arriving in London no later than May 24th. For convenience, it is recommended that you fly into London Heathrow Airport as the transportation links to student accommodation are most convenient from this location.
- Obtain or Renew Your Passport** – If you do not have a passport or need to replace an expired one, please be sure to order a new one as soon as possible.
