B.S.F.C. HDFS Career Track for FCS Teacher Licensure Program Notes:

- As a senior, students will then take the remaining courses needed to meet Wyoming and Colorado certification/ licensure requirements at CSU in Ft. Collins. In their last semester, Wyoming students may complete their student teaching requirements in Southern Wyoming FCS school classrooms with supervision by an FCS teacher educator. Students obtain expertise in areas needed to teach Family and Consumer Sciences in Wyoming and other state secondary school programs. Concurrent enrollment semesters will be required. By participating in this partnership, students earn dual bachelor's degrees—one from UW and one from CSU. Students must earn a minimum of 154 credit hours between the two programs (minimum of 120 at UW and a minimum of 34 at CSU) in order to be awarded a degree from each institution. In addition, students meet the requirements to apply for certification/licensure in Wyoming and in Colorado. Both licenses are reciprocal in many other states.

- Upon declaring this career track, students must satisfactorily complete a mandatory security screen (background check).

- Students must meet all entry requirements at UW and CSU. Students in the CSU licensure program are required to earn a C or above in all content courses and teacher licensing courses, and a passing score on the appropriate licensing exam. Therefore, a C or above must be earned in all courses and an overall 2.750 GPA to be transferred to CSU to fulfill their program requirements.

- The major requires students to earn a total of 120 credit hours; 42 credit hours or more must be at the 3000-level or above.

- Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

College of Agriculture and Natural Resources

- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
