B.S. Psychology Program Notes:

- A minimum of 33 hours in psychology are required for majors but the total cannot exceed 60 hours. Eighteen (18) of these psychology credit hours must be at the 3000-level or above to graduate. Also, the upper division courses must be taken from at least two different members of the psychology department faculty listed in the University Catalog. All major courses require a grade of C or better to graduate. Students with an established UW GPA who wish to change to or add the Psychology major are required to have a minimum 2.5 UW GPA.
- Math, Science & CM Electives must be selected with advisor's approval from Department list. General Electives cannot meet any other requirement for the major. Electives should be selected to satisfy the 42 hour upper division requirement.
- Psychology courses taken 15+ years ago will not be used to satisfy degree requirements.
- Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG).
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
