BA Design/Tech Concentration Program Notes:

- A minimum of 120 hours is required.
- A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division (3000 & 4000 level).
- Math, Science & CM Electives must be selected with advisor's approval from Department list. General Electives cannot meet any other requirement for the major. Electives should be selected to satisfy the 42 hour upper division requirement.
- Degree Candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses required for the major. • Grades of C or better are required for all prerequisite courses.
- A single language must be taken for two (2) semester or either (8) hours to fulfill the foreign language requirement for the program. Students taking American Sign Language to fulfill the language requirement for the major will have to take other courses to fulfill the H and USP requirements.
- This degree program permits a total of 60-70 credits in the major. It is designed primarily for students who seek additional professional training in theatre and dance or who wish to enter MFA graduate programs. Participation in the London Semester or a study abroad program is recommended. Please consult with an advisor.
- Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG).
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

Additional Information

Research in Theatre. This is a collaborative and devised project developed in consultation with an instructor. Students in the program will have the option of petitioning for permission to serve on the production staff of a departmental production as a designer or a technician. Ordinarily, the petition would be submitted to the departmental faculty during the student's junior year and the project would be completed in the student's senior year. A grade of C or better is required in all major courses. A grade of C- does not meet the requirement.
