Music Program Notes:

- A minimum of 120 hours is required.
- A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division (3000 & 4000 level).
- Math, Science & CM Electives must be selected with advisor's approval from Department list. General Electives cannot meet
- Degree Candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses required for the major. • Grades of C or better are rquired for all prerequisite courses.
- MATH 2350 may replace MATH 2200 but student must also have MATH 1405.
- MATH 1405 may be satisfied with Level 5 of the Math placement exam or Math ACT of 27 or SAT Math of 340. Students
- Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major

College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
