NOTES FOR ADVISORS

- 1 Transfer students who earn an AA, AS or AB are waived from all USP requirements except COM3, V, and departmental reqs (MATH 1400 & 2350). FYS is waived for transfer students with 30 or more credits earned after HS, or 1 full year completed at another college (but less than 30 credits completed). COM3 automatically fulfills old I, L reqs.
- 2 Must earn a C or better.
- 3 Or equivalent course.
- 4 A transfer student may fulfill COM2 with an intermediate composition course and a public speaking course.
- 5 PN & H may not be fulfilled by AGEC courses or any course cross-listed with AGEC. For the H requirement, language courses are strongly encouraged (e.g., SPAN 1010, FREN 1010, etc.)
- 6 18 hours of upper-division, not including AGEC 4965 or 4970.
- 7 Suggest COSC 1200 for most, or AGRI 1010 (for inexperienced users), or IMGT 2400 (for advanced users).
- 8 Required to take 1 course each in POLS, GEOG, and SOC, plus a minimum of 2 addt'l courses. Students may satisfy this with an equivalent INST course. A max of 3 credits of AGEC 4930 can be applied.
- 9 An approved international experience or internship is highly recommended for the International Ag option.
- 10 If a student earns a minor in a foreign language (6 hrs beyod 12 min required), then 6 credits of International Social Sci, Bus, Econ can be waived.
