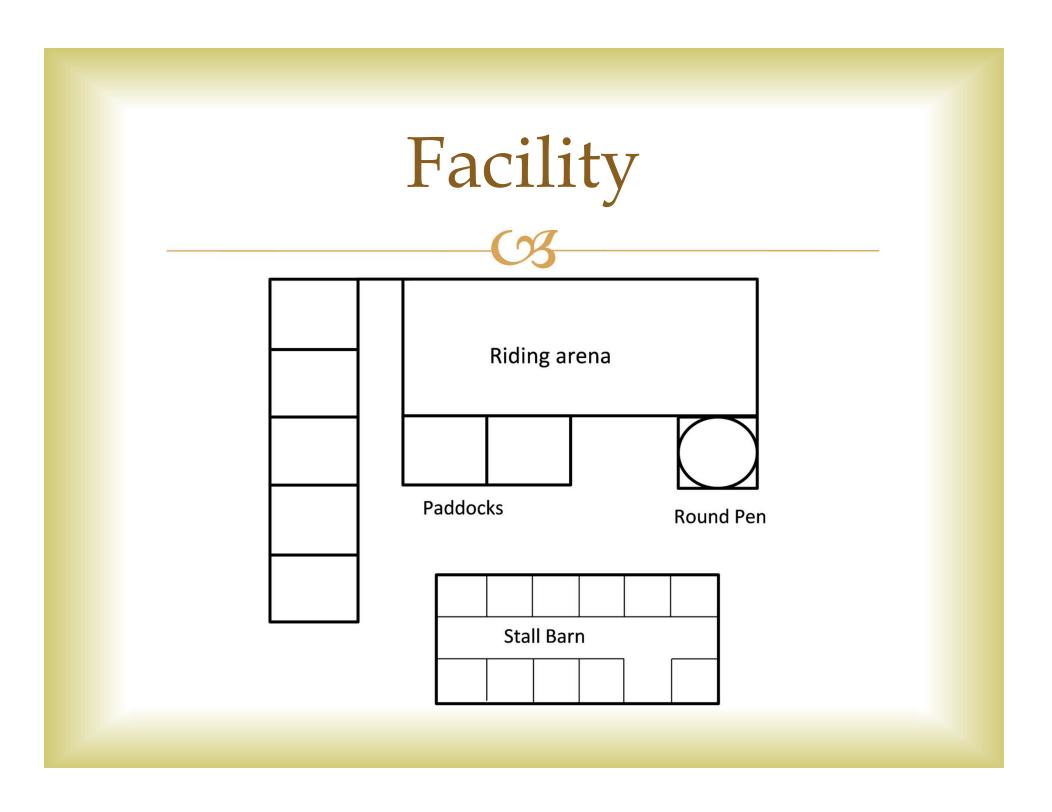

Operations Plan Cont.

Methods of Production
 Feed schedule: twice daily
 Cleaning schedule
 Stalls and paddocks once daily
 Stalls stripped once weekly
 Riding arenas will be graded every other day

Financial Plan

Financial Plan Cont.

Cash flow Projections
 With facility at capacity
 Revenue is equal to \$41,560 per month
 \$4,200 in profits
 Cash flows will be the greatest during the spring-summer months
