GERALD McBOING BOING, A Children's Story for Narrator, Percussion Solo and Nine Instruments, based on the Columbia Pictures release "Gerald McBoing Boing" produced by United Artists Productions of America by Gail Kubik. Academy Award-winning cartoon by the same name. Score was written before cartoon was made, before the cartoonists story-board had been drawn; the score for the film took on a completely musical architecture which permitted me to convert it into a work for the concert hall without loss of addition of a simple note. The only change: Gerald instead of speaking sound effects became the greatest percussion player in the world. To show off his prowess I worked out, for the concert piece, a little percussion concerto. Signed/Gail Kubik.
