COMPANY HISTORY: The American Creosoting Company was founded in 1907 in Richmond, Indiana, and quickly acquired several other companies in the United States that worked in wood preservation. Alfred L. Kuehn was elected president of the company in 1921 and his sons, Charles Chacey and George W. Kuehn, also served as executives with the company. The company merged with United States Creosoting Company in 1950 (which was founded in 1949 by members of the Kuehn family), and it in turn was acquired by Union Bag Camp Paper Corporation in 1956.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: Collection documents the corporate activities of the American Creosoting Company and its related companies from 1905-1956. The collection has been divided into two series: American Creosoting Company Records and affiliated company records. In each series the material is arranged alphabetically by name or subject and chronologically thereunder.

Series 1. American Creosoting Company Records, 1907-1956. 1.75 cubic ft. (4 boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Contains Board of Director's Minutes of meetings from 1907-1956 and various certificates of stock that the company offered for sale.

Series 2. Affiliated Company Records, 1905-1950. .63 cubic ft. (2 boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Contains a variety of minutes and stock certificates of companies that the American Creosoting Company acquired or held interest in.
