A photograph of the J.D. Woodruff cabin. This was the first white man's cabin built in what is now Big Horn County. It was built by John Dwight Woodruff, who was the first white settler in the Basin country, Wyoming. This cabin is on Owl Creek (now on the Eubar Ranch owned by Col. Jay L. Torrey). When built, the nearest neighbor was 150 miles away at Fort Washakie.
