Introduction

The Arthur Goldschmidt Papers were received in four shipments. The first two shipments in 1980 and 1981 consisted of correspondence with Sir Julian Huxley, correspondence and material from Goldschmidt's service at the United Nations.

A third shipment in 1989 consisted of papers, correspondence, reports, pamphlets, periodicals and books covering his tenure as an ambassador to the United Nations and a member of Non-Governmental Organizations at the United Nations, and papers relating to his private and professional interests. The file folders were in no particular order but were labeled by subject.

The fourth shipment in 1991 was a small addition to the Julian Huxley material.

All files were correlated and arranged by subject. Seven cubic feet of printed materials were separated.

Biography

Arthur "Tex" Goldschmidt, born in 1910 in San Antonio, Texas, was a career international civil servant working for both the United States and the United Nations in the fields of administration and diplomacy.

He received his A.B. from Columbia University in 1932 and began undergraduate studies in economics which he did not complete. In 1933 he married Elizabeth Wickenden and began work for the Federal Emergency Relief Administration in Washington D. C. From 1942 to 1947 he was Director of the Division of Power, Department of the Interior. He began his association with the United Nations in 1950 as a director of Coordination and Planning for the Technical Assistance Administration and as advisor to the United States Delegation to Geneva Economic and Social Council. He was active in initiating multi-lateral programs for technical assistance to developing countries. From 1967 to 1969 he served as the United States representative to the United Nations Economic and Social Council. He continued his United Nations activities by working as a consultant for international organizations developing or appraising projects and programs in Asia, Africa and Latin America. Following his retirement in 1980 he worked in New York with representatives of volunteer organizations on seminars and forums supporting development and international economic cooperation.

Mr. Goldschmidt was a Visiting Fellow of the Council on Foreign Relations and a member of the Academy of Independent Scholars and the Franklin Book Program. He was the author of numerous articles published in journals and periodicals relating to resources and technological development.

In 1989 Arthur Goldschmidt and his wife Elizabeth Wickenden moved to Haverford Pennsylvania. Tex and Wicky Goldschmidt are the parents of three children, Arthur, Jr.; Mrs. Ann Richardson; and Mrs. Jean Kempton, deceased.

Series Description

The Arthur Goldschmidt Papers are arranged in 4 series:

Series I. Julian Huxley Material, 1943-1991. (4 folders). Arranged alphabetically. Contents include correspondence from Julian Huxley to Arthur Goldschmidt, as well as scripts for Sir Julian's memorial, reprints of Julian Huxley's articles, and a transcription of an oral tape entitled "Letters And Memorabilia Relating to Julian Huxley" by Arthur Goldschmidt.

Series II. United Nations, 1952-1989.

Subseries 1. Non-Governmental Organizations, 1958-1988. 6.3 cubic ft. (14 document boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Conference material, correspondence, minutes of meetings, and reports of the various non-governmental organizations of which Arthur Goldschmidt was a member.

Subseries 2. Miscellaneous United Nations Activities, 1952-1989. 2.5 cubic ft. (6 document boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Includes United Nations activities other than that of non-governmental organizations, as well as United States policies toward the United Nations.

Subseries 3. Southeast Asia, 1957-1976. 3.5 cubic ft. (8 document boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Reports, correspondence, pamphlets regarding the Mekong River Basin projects and reconstruction in southeast Asia, and a transcription of an oral tape entitled "Mekong File Memo" by Arthur Goldschmidt.

Series III. Professional and Personal Activities, 1949-1989. 2.3 cubic ft. (5 document boxes). Arranged alphabetically. Material in these folders is from the private interests of Arthur Goldschmidt as well as organizations other than the United Nations. The files include some personal correspondence, mementos of trips, material from various organizations and conferences as well as testimony before the New York Power Authority.

Series IV. Audio-Visual Materials, 1980, no date. (2 items). Audio-cassette tapes dictated by Arthur Goldschmidt regarding the Julian Huxley material and the Mekong River Project in Southeast Asia. Transcripts are available with those series.

Scope and Content

The Arthur Goldschmidt Papers, 1943-1991, include personal and professional correspondence and material collected by Mr. Goldschmidt concerning Julian Huxley. Also included is an oral history on tape dictated by Arthur Goldschmidt regarding Julian Huxley.

Mr. Goldschmidt's years of service with the United Nations are reflected in correspondence, reports and articles. The bulk of the material covers his association with various non-governmental organizations. Although arranged by subject such as World Tourism Organization and Society for International Development, there are cross-references to other organizations in each subject file. There is little information from his years as ambassador the United Nations Economic and Social Council and no material from his 1957-1958 sabbatical in Iran as Chief of the United Nations Mission on Resources and Industry. Most of the material in the Southeast Asia file concerns the Lower Mekong River Project in the form of official reports. There is information on reconstruction in Southeast Asia, and an oral history entitled Mekong File Memo is included in the collection.

The personal correspondence consists for the most part of congratulations on his appointment as Ambassador the United Nations Economic and Social Council. The remaining correspondence reflects his involvement with various organizations such as the Academy of Independent Scholars and the Franklin Book Program. Included are conference documents from a 1955 International Conference on Regional Planning and Development in London, papers from the Council on Foreign Relations and supporting papers for the World Food and Nutrition Study with the National Research Council.
