Winthrop Ballantine was born on June 13, 1762, in Westfield, Massachusetts. It is unclear from his journal, but he may have been either a physician or an assistant to George Washington during the Revolutionary War.

The collection consists of a journal and copies of the journal. Included in it are copies of letters and general orders from George Washington to his troops, copies of letters from Ballantine to military leaders concerning the formation of the Society of Cincinnatus (a social organization for Revolutionary War soldiers), an invoice of medicines, prescriptions, and miscellaneous receipts.
