#### Introduction

The Donald Kent Stanford Papers were donated to the American Heritage Center by Mr. Stanford's wife, Frances Stanford, in two shipments, one 4 November 1994, and one 19 July 1995. The papers were received in good condition and in good order. Mr. Stanford's original arrangement of manuscripts, correspondence and clippings has been maintained, with loose papers being incorporated into this arrangement. A few personal papers have been made into a separate series. Receipts and manuscript copies exceeding two have been separated from the collection. Copies have been made of items on damaged paper, and staples and metal paper clips removed.

#### Biography

Donald Kent Stanford (1918-1992?) was an American novelist, short story writer and author of scripts for films and television. He was the author of 24 novels, including *The Red Car* (1954), *Treasure of the Coral Reef* (1956), *The Horsemasters* (1957), and *Mulligan's Pirates* (1966). He was also a contributor of over one hundred short stories and articles to magazine including *Redbook, Argosy, Woman's Day, Cosmopolitan, This Week, Hitchcock, Coronet, Writer, True, Collier's, Saturday Evening Post, Reader's Digest, and Holiday.* 

Mr. Stanford attended Drexel Institute of Technology, Foreign Service Institute and the University of Paris. He was a member of *Writer's Guild, Lambs Club, Metropolitan Club*, and *Cercle Interalliees*.

Born in Chattanooga, Tennessee in 1918, Mr. Stanford was the son of Arthur Stanley Hannibal and Katherine (Rush) Stanford. He married Frances Isabelle Schulman and was the father of two sons. For many years, they lived in Brantford, Ontario. His avocational interests included gourmet food, wines, travel, horses, skiing and piloting airplanes.

#### Series Description

The Donald Kent Stanford Papers are arranged in 3 series:

- Series I. Manuscripts and Miscellaneous Writings, 1947-1992. 2.25 cubic ft. (5 document boxes). Arranged alphabetically by title. Contains published and unpublished manuscripts for novels, short stories, articles, plays, and television productions, research materials, and correspondence relating to these manuscripts. Also contains book reviews written by Stanford.
- Series II. Correspondence, 1946-1992. 1.15 cubic ft. (2 document boxes, 11 folders). Arranged alphabetically by name. Contains correspondence with publishers, other business partners, professional contacts, fans, and family members.
- Series III. Clippings, 1961-1987. .20 cubic ft. (13 folders). Arranged alphabetically by subject.

#### Scope and Content

The Donald Kent Stanford Papers, 1946-1992, include manuscripts, correspondence and clippings documenting his life as a writer. Information about his personal life is very limited. The manuscripts (Series I) cover published and unpublished writing of all types but are primarily short stories. Correspondence and research notes relating to each manuscript is foldered with the manuscript. Three of the manuscript folders (1. West Tours; 2. Porlock Riding School; and 3. Running of the Bulls) contain black and white photographs.

The correspondence (Series II), primarily related to his writing, includes material from publishers, family, and fans.
