Maj Eslinger assessed aviation wildlife strike mitigation programs across 3 bases, synchronizing lines of effort, improving compliance, and reducing risk to 308 aircrew and 31 aircraft. He managed manned flying operations notification changes for each Missile Wing's unmanned aerial system operations, decreasing the risk of catastrophic collisions.

Maj Eslinger adjudicated and released 27 mishap investigation reports, documenting trends and highlighting potential for safer, more effective UH-1N operations. He coordinated with 4 separate wing safety offices to analyze 115 mishaps, providing the 20 AF/CC detailed trends of 5 years of flight, weapons, and ground safety incidents.
