Jacobsen is the Noncommissioned Officer in Charge of Personnel and Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Training Instructor at Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Detachment 940, The University of Wyoming, Laramie, Wyoming. MSgt Jacobsen serves as the detachment Key Enlisted Leader and primary enlisted advisor to the detachment commander on cadet academics, professional development programs, military training, and discipline. He assists in educating cadets on Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps curriculum, as well as supporting cadet life cycle management, completes actions for contracting, commissioning, Extended Active Duty, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Field Training, and other events/programs. He is responsible for developing quality leaders for the Air Force and the nation.



Master Sergeant Jacobsen enlisted as a Firefighter in the United States Air Force in September 2005. MSgt Jacobsen has served in several career-broadening assignments including Department of Defense Courier, Non-Commissioned Officer In Charge of Courier Operations, and Defense Courier Division Liaison to Headquarters United States Air Force, Air Force Element Program Resource Office, Detachment 4.
