Our thoughtfully designed indoor spaces and expansive grounds are ideal for retreats, meetings, workshops, and gatherings of all kinds. Whether you're bringing people together to reflect, collaborate, or celebrate, the Neltje Center provides a memorable backdrop where ideas—and relationships—can flourish.



ABOUT THE NELTJE CENTER

The 15,000 sq ft Neltje Center building is a uniquely designed space with a meandering floor plan that stretches nearly 100 yards long. Two large meeting rooms and several more intimate gathering spaces, make it ideal for large and small groups alike. The Center is equipped with the following:

- 55' x 35' Main Living Room
- 55' x 60' Multi-purpose Gallery
- Studio/Workshop Room (plus a larger studio in a separate building)
- 5+ Breakout Spaces of various sizes
- 2 Kitchens
- 6 Bathrooms
- Outdoor patios and a Sculpture Garden Meadow
- Parking that accommodates up to 70 vehicles
- Overnight accommodations for 6 upon request

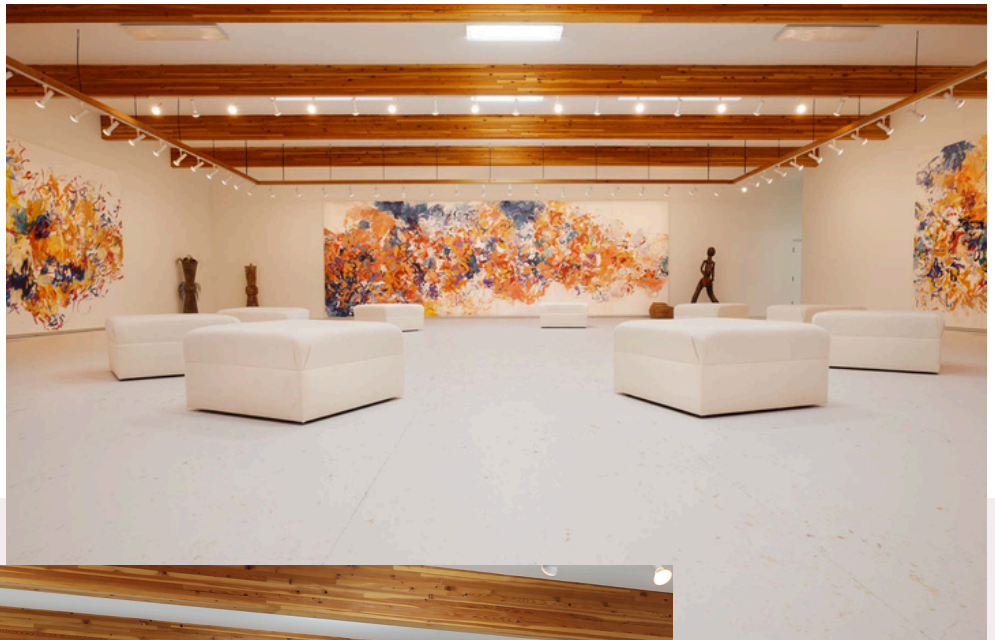


Note: Because the Neltje Center is housed in a historic home, accessibility can vary throughout the space. We are committed to accommodating guests with mobility needs whenever possible.

GALLERY

The Neltje Center's impressive art-filled gallery can be used not only for dining, dancing, or music performances, but also for cocktail receptions, social gatherings or workshops. Additionally it can be used as a backup space for outdoor events in case of inclement weather. Large moveable ottomans provide casual seating; 100 chairs are available for more formal seating.

GATHERING SPACES: MAIN LIVING ROOM



The Main Living Room is the heart of the Neltje Center—a warm, inviting space where meaningful conversations naturally unfold. Ideal for relaxing and dining, the room is also perfect for casual meetings, and cocktail receptions, presentations (AV equipment available). Floor-to-ceiling windows provide stunning views of the outdoor sculpture garden and Bighorn Mountains.

GATHERING SPACES: ROUND KITCHEN



The Round Kitchen is located near the main entrance and connects seamlessly to both the Main Living Room and the Rock Room, making it an ideal hub for catering setup, food service, and the display of appetizers or drinks. Its circular layout naturally encourages easy conversation, and guests often enjoy gathering here with a drink in hand, blending functional convenience with a welcoming, social atmosphere.

GATHERING SPACES: ROCK ROOM



Featuring a round table with seating for six, along with two armchairs and a loveseat, the Rock Room is an ideal space for small gatherings. With two of its four walls composed of windows and sliding glass doors, the room is filled with natural light, and offers a seamless transition between indoor and outdoor spaces.

Located adjacent to the Round Kitchen and the Main Living Room, it works beautifully as a breakout room, cocktail area, bar space, or a comfortable pass-through for guests heading out to the flagstone patio or Sculpture Garden Meadow.

GATHERING SPACES: SUNROOM + OLD LIVING ROOM

Located just off the original kitchen, the Sunroom and Old Living Room offer warm, intimate spaces ideal for small gatherings or breakout conversations. The Sunroom is filled with natural light and features a spacious writing desk and a distinctive butterfly cantilevered ceiling.



The Old Living Room provides comfortable seating along with a dining area that accommodates up to ten guests, creating a welcoming setting for conversation and connection.



GATHERING SPACES: NELTJE'S SITTING ROOM + THE TOWER

With a beautiful mountain view, Neltje's Sitting Room is a perfect intimate space. There are 2 love seats and an armchair, a fireplace, and a hidden wet bar.



The Tower is a small round room at the top of a floating spiral staircase. With an artfully crafted metal desk and 2 arm chairs, it's an ideal place for 1-3 people to collaborate.



CATERING KITCHEN

The Neltje Center kitchen is the perfect place for your group or your caterer to prep hors d'oeuvres, main courses, and anything in between. Amenities include:

- 1 full-size refrigerator
- 1 industrial-size double door refrigerator
- 1 full-size freezer
- 2 ovens
- 2 microwaves
- 1 stove top
- 12' long tabletop for plating



PATIO + SCULPTURE GARDEN MEADOW



Events can take place in the Center's backyard Garden Meadow where you can enjoy a magical view of the Bighorn Mountains while surrounded by an array of intriguing sculptural art.



The extensive flagstone patio is perfect for cocktails and the expansive lawn provides the ideal location for catering tents, dance floors, food trucks—whatever amenities you'd like to bring to your gathering.

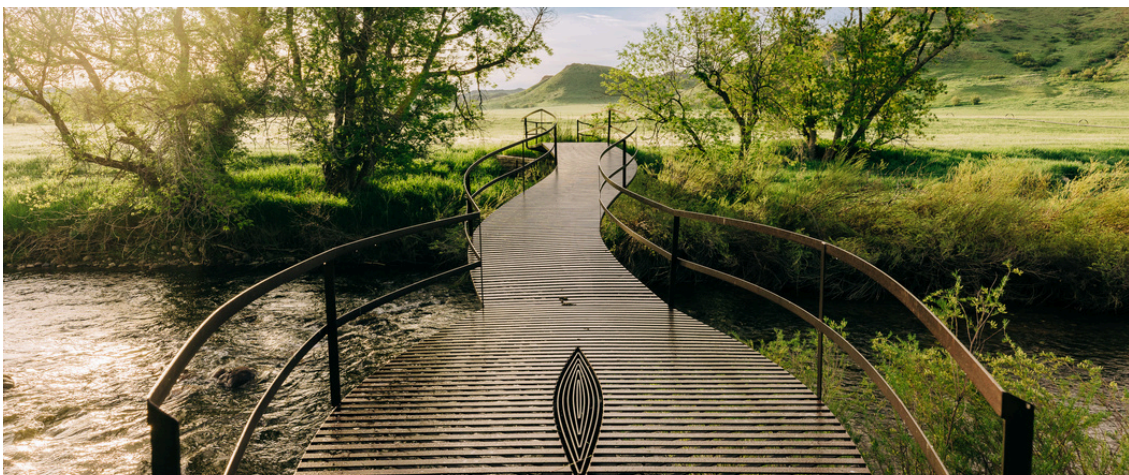


NORTH GARDEN + PINEY CREEK BRIDGE

On the north side of the house, guests will find a lush garden that overflows with flowers, herbs, vegetables, and even fruit during the warmer months. Nestled behind an artistic metal fence and surrounded by gently rolling hills and tall trees, the garden offers a peaceful and picturesque setting.



To the east, the property is bordered by Piney Creek. Guests can enjoy scenic views from a distinctive metal bridge, whose wavy design echoes the natural rhythm of Piney Creek. The bridge is both an immersive experience and a beautiful spot for photos.



STUDIO SPACE: NEW STUDIO

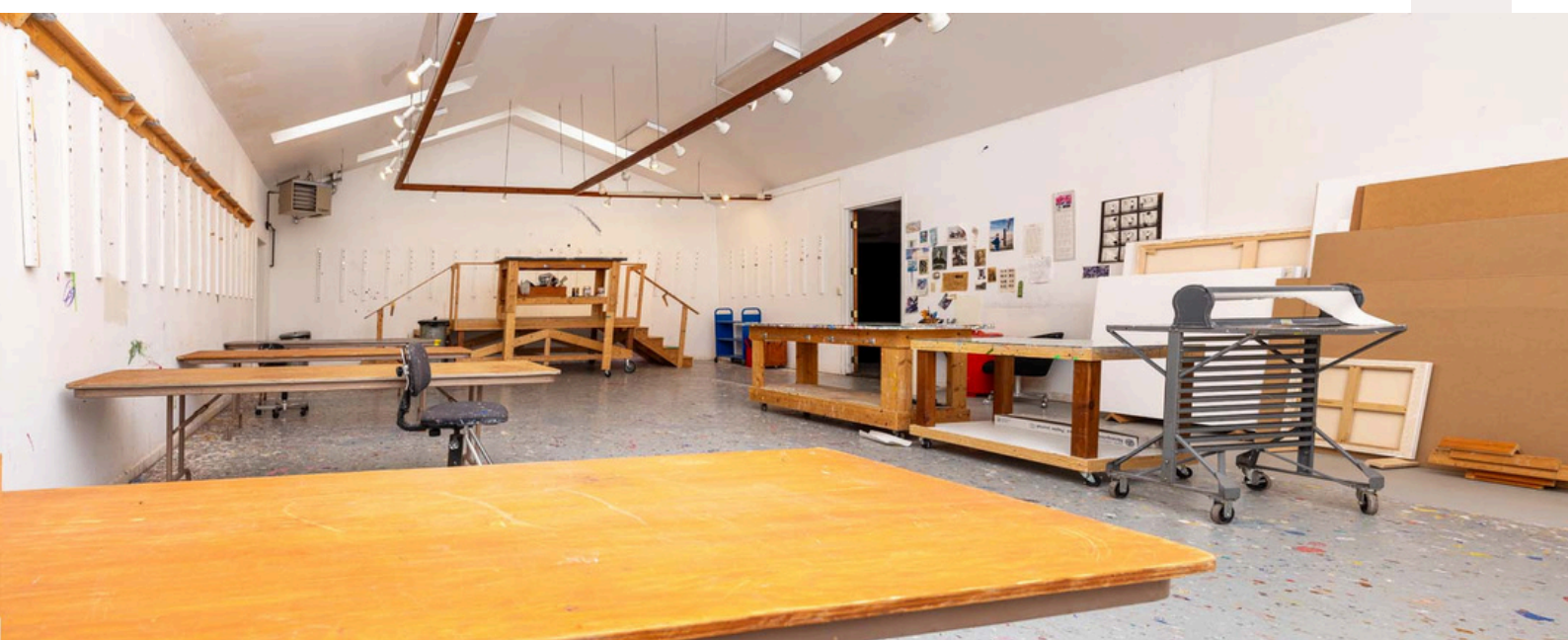
The New Studio is a bright, dynamic space located within the Neltje Center and surrounded by Neltje's large-scale canvases. With two generous worktables and stools, it's well suited for creative work, meetings, and brainstorming sessions. Amenities include a nearby sink for washing brushes and a private bathroom.



STUDIO SPACE: OLD STUDIO (DETACHED)

The Old Studio is a light-filled, creative workspace just steps from the Neltje Center's main entrance. Ideal for workshops and hands-on creativity, it includes everything needed to support focused, creative work.

PARKING

Our parking area can accommodate 70 vehicles. It's a 5-minute walk from parking to the Sculpture Garden Meadow.

Accessible parking is available in front of the Main Entrance and can accommodate 6 vehicles.

Overflow parking is available in the former Turned Antiques lot, which is a 10 minute walk down the driveway of the Neltje Center. Shuttle service can be arranged for an additional fee.
