Title: Spring and Easter Break Bill

Introduced: November 30, 1976

Thesis: Students want classes excused for Good Friday and Monday after Easter

Sponsor: Bill Mattison

1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming that beginning spring semester 1978, there be two
3. separate breaks in the spring semester. These breaks should be as follows:
4. A. A spring midterm break in which classes are excused for nine (9)
5. consecutive days beginning with the first Saturday after midterm;
6. B. An Easter break in which classes are excused for four (4) consecutive
7. days beginning with Good Friday.
8. C. If Easter break and Spring break fall within fourteen (14) days of
9. each other, there be a combined break scheduled at Easter.
