

SENATE BILL #1193

Title: Student Opinion Poll

Codification Number:

Introduced: February 1, 1977

Thesis: Recent events have made a student poll necessary

Sponsor: David Brickson

1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
2. of the University of Wyoming that whereas recent events have
3. led to a need to gauge student opinion toward President William
4. Carlson's performance in office and whereas this opinion should
5. be gathered in the most accurate and fairest manner possible;
6. be it enacted that the students of the University of Wyoming
7. be given the opportunity to respond by secret ballot at
8. designated polling places at the earliest possible time to
9. the following question: "Do you think President William
10. Carlson is administering the affairs of the University of
11. Wyoming in a manner that best serves the interests of the
12. University and the students?" Yes, No, No Opinion; (non-
13. votes counting as Yes.)
14. To ensure as large a vote as possible, be it further enacted
15. that absentee ballots be made available to the student body
16. at least one week before the designated date of the poll so
17. that students who will be unable to vote on the designated
18. date-for whatever reason-shall be able to respond.
19. It is recognized that any such poll is relevant only if
20. a significant majority of all enrolled students respond,
21. and any results should be viewed accordingly by all groups,
22. parties, and individuals concerned. It shall be emphasized
23. that the ONLY purpose of this poll is to gauge student opinion

- 24. toward Dr. Carlson and that it is NOT designed to embarrass
- 25. President Carlson or the University.
- 26. Be it further enacted that this bill carry an automatic
- 27. nullification clause if future circumstances make a student
- 28. poll either unnecessary or irrelevant.
