1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
2. of the University of Wyoming that the following definition of
3. ASUW Reserve Fund be made an addendum to Unireg 239 as section
4. 7:
5. 7. ASUW Reserve Fund
6. The Associated Students shall maintain a reserve fund, hereinafter
7. referred to as the "ASUW Reserve Fund". This reserve shall
8. consist of monies derived from the sources herein specified
9. under Paragraph 2 above, Sources of Funds. The accumulation
10. of these funds shall be maintained for the purpose of securing
11. the on-going development of the activities, programs, and
12. furtherance of the ideals of the Associated Students of the
13. University of Wyoming.
14. Establishment and authority for utilization of the ASUW Reserve
15. lies with the ASUW Finance Committee and consent of the ASUW
16. Student Senate. Any unbudgeted portion of the designated
17. "ASUW Fee" shall revert to the reserve fund. Monies not expended
18. from each fiscal year's budget shall also revert to the reserve
19. fund.
20. Such described funds may be invested in savings, securities,
21. and other prescribed holdings in accordance with the laws

22. and regulations of the State of Wyoming. All earnings
 23. derived from these investments shall revert to the ASUW
 24. Reserve Fund. The ASUW Reserve Fund shall be utilized by
 25. incorporating its support in the ASUW's operating budget,
 26. or submitting special budget requests to the Trustees of
 27. the University of Wyoming.
