


1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University
2. of Wyoming whereas: the students have demonstrated a need for the revision of
3. the current academic calendar, and whereas: there is no violation of state,
4. federal or accreditation guidelines by shortening the academic calendar, and
5. whereas the shortening of the academic calendar would be a benefit to many
6. students and make our calendar consistent with most universities in the Rocky
7. Mountain region; that the current academic calendar of the University be
8. shortened by five (5) days per semester.
