

Senate Resolution #1301

Title: Education of Advisors

Thesis: Training of advisors

1. Be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that a recommendation be made to the faculty senate
2. that an annual seminar be conducted for attendance of the University of Wyoming faculty who have been assigned as advisors for the year.
3. The purpose of the seminar would be to instruct new advisors of the basic concepts and/or specialized topics on the correct methods and purposes of student advisement. This seminar would also stress the necessity of helpful and correct ways of advising to faculty who have been advisors in the past. Advisors should be made aware of various information pertaining to academics, such as requirements of the University and more specifically, individual college course requirements and any substitutes that may be taken in their place, so that the advisor may be in a capacity to give knowledgeable advisement on academic matters. Advisors should also be able to interpret ACT scores so that students asking for information contained in them can be assured that their advisor can help them in choosing a major which is appropriate to their interests and capabilities. Advisors should also be made aware of the non-academic
