Title: Yearbook

Introduced: April 28, 1981

Thesis: Funding a yearbook

Sponsor: Kathy Marion

1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming that ASUW match funds with the University in the
3. amount of \$10,549.50 to provide for a 1981-82 yearbook. Funds from ASUW's
4. portion of the yearbook would come from unbudgeted fee money and ASUW
5. reserves. Copies of the yearbook would be sold at \$5. This agreement
6. would be only for the 1981-82 yearbook and, on the basis of an evaluation
7. of the success of the yearbook in 1981-82, a decision would be made on
8. future funding. This bill shall be void in the event an editor is not
9. chosen by June 15, 1981. See appendix for the proposed budget.
