1. Whereas Iron Skull members provide a traditional service to the students

4. the Skid, and whereas Iron Skull will also pay ASUW 50% of any profits
5. realized from the Skid, and whereas Iron Skull finances can't provide for
6. expenses (deposits, etc.) incurred before ticket revenue is generated:
7. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
8. University of Wyoming that \$1,920 be allocated for use by Iron Skull to
9. produce the Homecoming Skid. It is understood by Iron Skull said funds
10. will not be used to purchase liquor, and will be repaid from the proceeds
11. of the event. Appendix itemizes expenses


