Title: Capital Construction

1. Whereas, - - - decisions are being made by the University of Wyoming
2. Administration involving millions of dollars in capital construction
3. expenditures without significant student comment or input; and realizing
4. - - - that although administrative decisions of this nature are necessary
5. to prepare adequately the University's budget proposal for the next biennium,
6. these same decisions have a tremendous impact on both the academic environment
7. and the overall reputation of the University, Be it resolved by the
8. Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that
9. the University Administration should establish a formal procedure under which
10. at least the ASUW Senate and its committees may review and make comments on
11. capital construction expenditure proposals of the University, and Be it
12. further resolved that the University make known to the ASUW Senate and the
13. Student Body as a whole, by letter and publication in the Branding Iron,
14. proposals for capital construction and their respective priorities, as well
15. as an explanation of the needs for the proposed projects and the reasoning
16. used to establish the priorities assigned.
