- Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that a non-binding referendum be placed on the general election ballot of the Spring ASUW Election of 1985 stating: 1) should the ASUW continue to fund the GAS at the current level or, 2) should funding be reduced and reallocated to other problem areas affecting students such as, but not limited to, parking, day care facilities, recreational equipment, etc.
