

SENATE RESOLUTION #1505

Title: Support for change in Union Malt Beverage Policy

Introduced: May 3, 1985

Thesis:

1. Whereas currently malt beverages can be dispensed in the Union only in
2. the beer garden and an adjacent dining room and whereas student groups
3. that desire to have malt beverages dispensed at events elsewhere in the Union
4. must obtain a special permit from the Laramie City Council; Be it resolved
5. by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of
6. Wyoming that the Laramie City Council, the Union Board, the UW Board of
7. Trustees and the Administration of the University proceed with all deliberate
8. speed with plans to change university regulations and the Union's "special
9. malt beverage permit" to allow beer to be dispensed anywhere in the Union
10. without having to obtain City Council permission each time, although the
11. proposed University channels will be followed and approval of the Vice
12. President for Finance's Office must still be obtained. Be it further
13. resolved that a copy of this resolution shall be presented to the Board
14. of Trustees.
