1. Whereas the ASUW Student Senate represents a large number of 19 and 20
2. year olds living in Wyoming and whereas the Senate is fundamentally
3. concerned with the protection and preservation of the legitimate rights
4. and privileges of the aforementioned group, Be it resolved by the Student
5. Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the
6. Senate believes that a vast majority of 19 and 20 year olds in Wyoming
7. are responsible individuals who deserve and appreciate the rights and
8. privileges, specifically the privilege of consumption of alcoholic
9. beverages, conferred upon them by the Wyoming Legislature, and the Senate
10. humbly requests that the Legislature consider the possible unjust impact
11. upon those rights and privileges before enacting any legislation revoking
12. or curtailing those rights and privileges. Also, be it resolved that a
13. copy of this resolution shall be sent to the Governor and all of the members
14. of the Legislature and that the External Affairs Executive work to make
15. this position known to legislators during the next Legislative session.
