Appendix to Senate Bill #1546

The phones will be restricted to local area use, and no long distance calls can be made. Seven phones will be purchased and located in the following areas:

- Classroom Building
- Education Building
- Commerce and Industry Building
- Pharmacy Building
- Engineering Building
- Agriculture Building
- New Animal Science and Biochemistry Building

In addition there are currently campus restricted phones in the following buildings:

- basement of Coe Library
- Fine Arts Building
- Activities Center
- Science Library
- Physical Science Building

The costs of the lines are \$59.5 for installation and \$19.30 per month, and the telephones may be purchased from Stores for \$35.00.
