- 1. Whereas the current level of University of Wyoming funding cannot be
- 2. sustained for the 1988-1990 biennium without a recommended increase in
- 3. tuition, and whereas not increasing tuition would likely result in a
- 4. decrease in the programs and services now offered by the University of
- 5. Wyoming, and whereas the University of Wyoming has the lowest tuition
- 6. for a major comprehensive university in the region and the proposed
- 7. increase in tuition would not change this fact, and whereas the students
- 8. of the University of Wyoming recognize the necessity to maintain the
- 9. present quality of education; therefore, be it resolved that the Student
- 10. Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming support
- 11. the proposed increase of \$20.25 per semester for in-state tuition and
- 12. \$74.50 per semester for out-of-state tuition. Be it further resolved
- 13. that the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of
- 14. Wyoming support the \$2.75 per semester athletic fee increase.
