

SENATE RESOLUTION #1582

Title: University of Wyoming Funding and Space for Microcomputers
Introduced: October 27, 1987
Thesis: Resolution of ASUW in support of increased funding for micro-computer labs available for student use on campus.
Sponsor: Kevin O'Kane

1. Be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. that: whereas society is placing greater emphasis on people profi-
3. cient in the use of microcomputers; whereas the University of Wyoming,
4. in order to meet the criteria of society for a learned person, has
5. embraced instruction in microcomputers in its curriculum; whereas
6. this instruction has created student demand for accessible micro-
7. computers; whereas not only students, but personnel of the University
8. of Wyoming have access to the microcomputers provided in the micro-
9. computer labs, thus increasing the ratio of microcomputer practition-
10. ers to the number of microcomputers available; whereas the increase
11. in demand for microcomputers is not endemic to any college; and where-
12. as microcomputer purchases are a capital improvement, a financial respon-
13. sibility that should be borne by the University of Wyoming, the Univer-
14. sity of Wyoming institute a policy of increasing the level of funding
15. for microcomputers on campus and secondly of providing space for these
16. microcomputers, creating more microcomputer labs to which all students
17. and personnel of the University have access.
