Title: Policy for Repeated Courses

Introduced: January 19, 1988

Sponsors: Dan Dockham and David Miller

1. Whereas, a grade in a course should reflect the level that a student has
2. attained in mastering the required material; whereas, the said grade and
3. related G.P.A. are important to a student in demonstrating to a potential
4. employer or other entities that the student has reached a certain level of
5. mastery over a subject; whereas a policy of averaging the grades of
6. courses repeated would not accurately reflect the level of mastery
7. relating to the material of the repeated course; be it resolved by the
8. Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
9. that the senate recommends to the administration of the University of
10. Wyoming and to the Board of Trustees that no changes to Unireg 715 be
11. made.
