- 6. established by the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies; and
- whereas all student employees herein defined are excluded from regulation 7.
- applicable to staff employees and are not eligible for the benefits of 8.
- 9. staff employment; be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
- Students of the University of Wyoming that it support and encourage a 10.
- revision of Unireg 174 that would allow full-time University employees 11.
- who wish to enroll as full-time UW students the option of doing so, with 12.
- the approval of each individual's respective supervisor, allowing such 13.
- 14. students to be included in the regulations applying to staff employment
- 15. and remain eligible for such benefits of their employment as well as the
- 16. benefits of full-time fee paying students.
