- 10. ticket and student ID to the game; and whereas informal surveys have
- 11. shown that at some basketball games fewer than 50% of the persons sitting
- 12. in the lower parts of the student section are actually students; and
- 13. whereas numerous seats in the student section are left unused; and
- 14. whereas the increase in attendance will increase revenue immediately
- 15. through increased concession sales and parking by off-campus students:
- 16. and whereas the revocation of the ticket policy will increase student fan
- 17. support by increased spirit and enthusiasm; and whereas such increase in
- 18. support will enhance the team's performance thus creating a better
- 19. win/loss record which will attract the better players and lead to
- 20. national recognition; and whereas such recognition will increase future
- 21. revenue through increased national television coverage of Wyoming games
