- 11. H. The President may veto within TEN (10) DAYS of its
- 12. passage...following the veto.
- 13. 1. IF THE PRESIDENT FAILS TO ACT ON ANY PIECE OF LEGISLATION
- 14. WITHIN 10 DAYS OF PASSAGE, OR BEFORE THE NEW PRESIDENT IS
- 15. SWORN IN, THE LEGISLATION SHALL GO INTO EFFECT WITHOUT THE
- 16. PRESIDENT'S SIGNATURE.
- 17. 2. THE PRESIDENT SHALL PROVIDE A WRITTEN EXPLANATION OF ANY
- 18. VETO TO THE SENATE AT THE NEXT MEETING FOLLOWING THE VETO
- 19. OR BEFORE THE SUBSEQUENT SENATE IS SWORN IN, WHICHEVER IS
- 20. SOONER.
