Title: UW Home Child Care Provider Program Subsidy

Date: March 27, 1990

Sponsors: Kari Morgan and Susan Sherwood

1. Whereas non-traditional students are 30% of the UW student body; and
2. whereas many of these students have children that are in need of child
3. care; and whereas a substantial number of ASUW members are in need of
4. quality, low cost child care; and whereas in the past, ASUW has funded the
5. UW Home Child Care Provider Program; and whereas this funding has enabled
6. this program to triple in size since 1987; and whereas it is necessary
7. that the program have consistent funding each fiscal year in order to be
8. able to continue to provide quality, low-cost child care to ASUW members;
9. and whereas grants do not provide a source of consistent funding; and
10. whereas the UW Home Child Care Program provides a direct service to many
11. students and could expand further with adequate funding; be it enacted
12. that ASUW provide appropriate funding for the UW Home Child Care training
13. program to be available to all full fee-paying UW students beginning FY
14. 1992 and will be subject to the standard budgeting process.
