Title: Tuition Increase

1. Whereas the University of Wyoming is in need of additional revenue to
2. help maintain the quality of education; and whereas the University of
3. Wyoming is a land grant institution and it receives money from the
4. federal government as well as the State of Wyoming, and whereas the U.S.
5. citizens who attend the University of Wyoming pay twice for their
6. education through taxes and tuition, and whereas non-U.S. citizens only
7. contribute the amount of out-of-state tuition to their University
8. education, which is an inequitable cost distribution; therefore be it
9. resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
10. University of Wyoming that it recommend to the Board of Trustees that
11. they establish a third level of tuition to be paid by non-U.S. citizens
12. who attend the University of Wyoming.
