1. WHEREAS, the proceedings of the ASUW Senate can be
2. significantly affected by the interpretation of the rules
3. governing said proceedings; and
4. WHEREAS, there is no body providing a basis for the
5. interpretation of the rules governing proceedings;
6. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
7. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that a Rules
8. Committee be established as an ad-hoc committee with the
9. authority to make decisions governing the interpretation of
10. the rules. It shall be chaired by the vice president of ASUW
11. and its membership shall consist of the president pro tempore,
12. the parliamentarian, one senator-at-large and one constitution
13. committee member, both appointed by the chairperson of
14. Constitution Committee.
