1. WHEREAS, the ASUW Student Senate is currently bound by its

- 2. By-Laws to hold a primary election as well as a general
- 3. election in the selection of its membership; and
- 4. WHEREAS, the purpose of a primary election is to reduce the
- 5. field of viable candidates on the general ballot; and
- 6. WHEREAS, such reductions in past ASUW elections have in most
- 7. cases been negligible within the college senate races; and
- 8. WHEREAS, the use of primary elections is most practically
- 9. applied within the arena of partisan politics; a system which
- 10. does not pertain to ASUW elections;
- 11. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
- 12. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the ASUW
- 13. By-Laws (Article III, Section A, Paragraph 1) be amended to
- 14. read "There shall be a general election with an optional
- 15. primary election at the discretion of the ASUW Senate
- 16. Elections Committee with the approval of the ASUW Senate"; and
- 17. be it further enacted that the ASUW By-Laws (Article III,
- 18. Section B, Paragraph 2) be amended to read "In the event of a
- 19. primary election for President and Vice President, each voter
- 20. shall vote for not more than one candidate for ASUW President
- 21. and one candidate for ASUW Vice President."; and

- 22. be it further enacted that the ASUW By-Laws (Article III,
- 23. Section B, Paragraph 3) be amended to read "In the event of a
- 24. primary for senators, each student shall be permitted a number
- 25. of votes equal to the number of senators being selected from
- 26. his college.
