- 7. University Bookstore, and various professors on campus receive
- 8. requests from individuals and organizations in the world
- 9. asking for books; and
- 10. WHEREAS, many people, retired professors, Staff
- 11. Council members, UW Bookstore employees, the director of Coe
- 12. Library, and the recycling coordinator, desire to develop a
- 13. program for book recycling; and
- 14. WHEREAS, staff members and UW Bookstore personnel are
- 15. interested in assisting with the the collection of used,
- 16. non-returnable books in the Union and at the Campus Shop
- 17. during finals week of the fall and spring semesters; and
- 18. WHEREAS, ASUW could assist in the collection and coordination
- 19. of such a program;
