12. 1 of the ASUW Constitution the following be inserted at the
13. end of the paragraph: "This committee exists essentially to
14. direct legislation to other committees for their
15. consideration."
16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that in paragraph 2 the
17. following be added after "Committees": "The Steering
18. Committee shall have no authority to amend or suggest
19. amendments to legislation."
